Inspiring a love of reading and helping kids be prepared to learn and succeed!

Read with Me focuses on reading aloud to preschool children to help develop a love of reading while improving early literacy skills.



WHAT?

Women United Reading Programs **Read With Me & Read To Succeed**

WHY??

When children are read to at an early age, they are more likely to develop a true love of reading. At the same time, children not reading at grade level by 3rd grade are less likely to be successful in school and beyond. The ability to read impacts graduation rates, career access, and crime rates.

WHEN?

Both programs run during the school year, early October through mid-May, and during the school day.

Read With Me = 30- 60 minutes/week

Read To Succeed = 30 minutes/week

WHERE?

We are currently serving children in all 4 counties!

HOW?

Read With Me: The volunteer spends 30-60 minutes in a PreK class reading aloud to one child at a time.

A volunteer may read to several different children during each session.

Read to Succeed: The volunteer meets each week with the same child. During the 30-minute period, the volunteer works with the child to improve different aspects of their reading skills. These may include comprehension, fluency, or confidence, to name a few.
